
Preparatory 6 Summer School

In line with our school vision "To create a loving, secure and modern environment to deliver an education that will help our children unlock their potential and develop into the next generation of leaders in our Spiritual Capital", we would like to extend our welcome and share our excitement for the promise of a new academic year at Dar al Zahra Charitable Schools. It is a true privilege to have the opportunity to educate and improve orphans' lives in Najaf and on behalf of all the teachers and staff at Dar Al Zahra, we want to thank all our sponsors and donors for their continues support in assisting us to educate the orphans of Najaf.

During the summer, painting, repairs and maintenance work of the whole building was completed. New emergency exit staircase was installed and grass carpet was put in the boys sports ground. For the new academic year, all the students are being provided with 2 sets of new school uniform, a new school bag, stationery, text books, and Shoes.

Dar al Zahra schools welcome 127 new students. 97 are orphans and the rest are students who can not afford fees. A very few are paying students. Most of our new admissions are Primary 1 Boys and Girls. Currently, we have 923 students with a capacity to accommodate up to 1,200. Our student body is comprised of 489 girls (53%) and 434 boys (47%). 86% (790 students) of our current student body are orphans. We have 133 students that are non-orphans.


