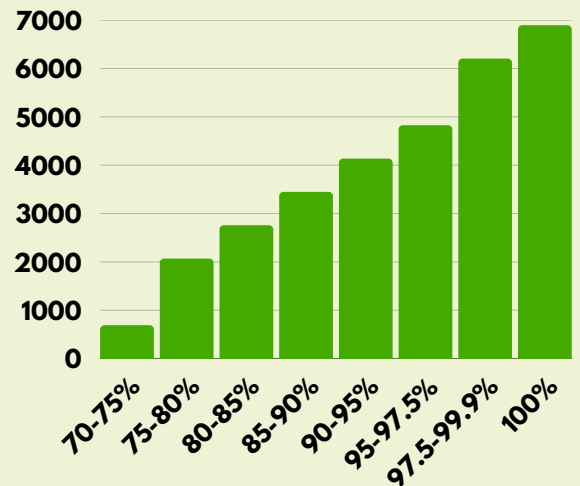
EMPOWERING FUTURE LEADERS THROUGH THE GRADUATE GRANT SCHEME!

GRANT POLICY

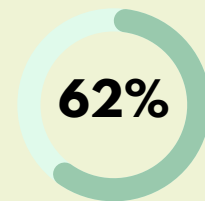
- To confirm continuing student status, the student must provide an official letter from the university.
- Students must maintain the academic performance required by the institution (good average and above).
- Students are required to submit their results each time they receive the grant.
- The financial grant will terminate when the student completes their selected program of study.
- The sponsor or school reserves the right to terminate the student's grant eligibility at any time.
- If a student fails the final exam for any stage, the financial grant will be terminated.



This grant awards varying USD amounts based on the students Grade 12 percentage, as detailed in the percentage bracket breakdown within the graph.

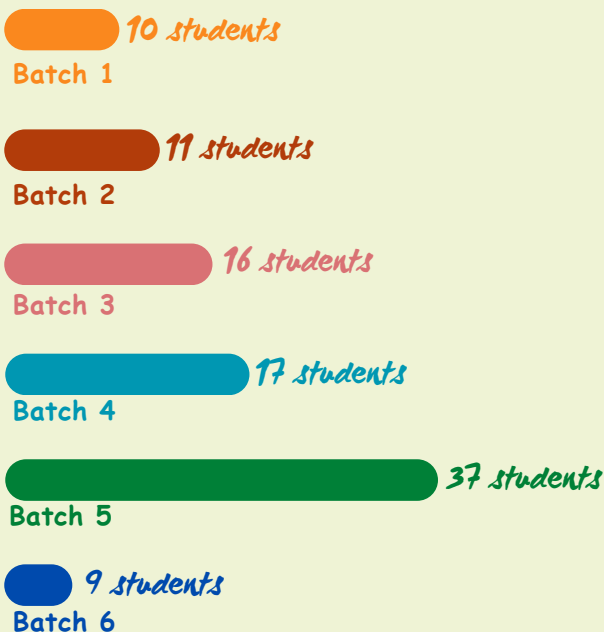
62% of our graduates are successfully receiving grant!

We're committed to continuing to empower our graduates and look forward to even greater success in the future.

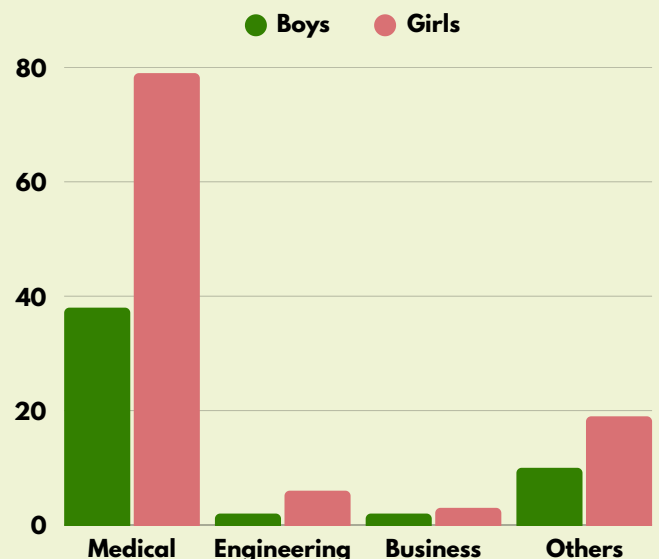


Over all Grant Rate

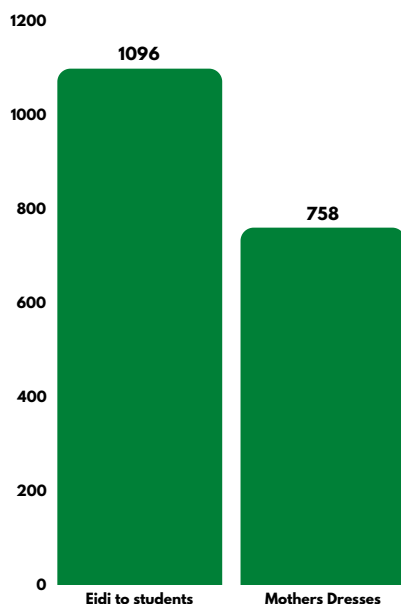
