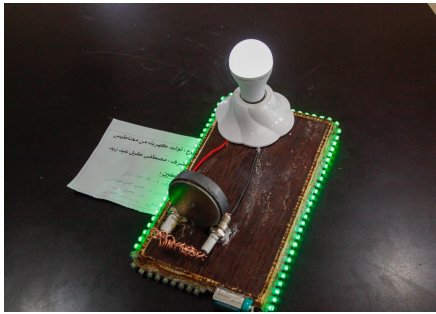

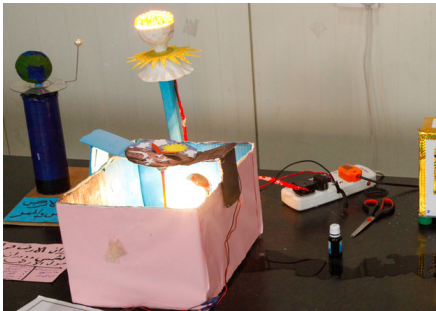

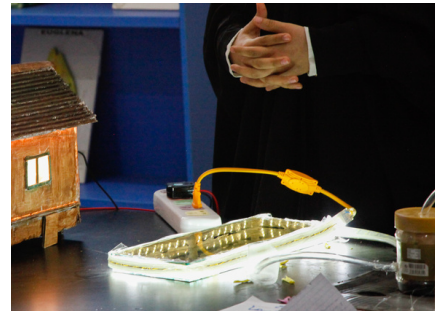

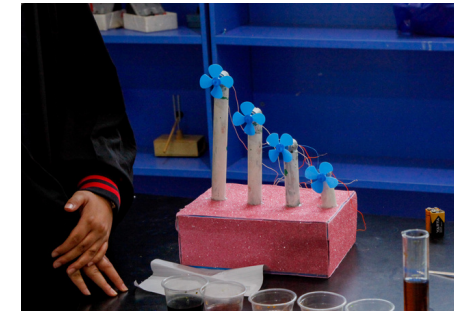
Drip Irrigation Working Model

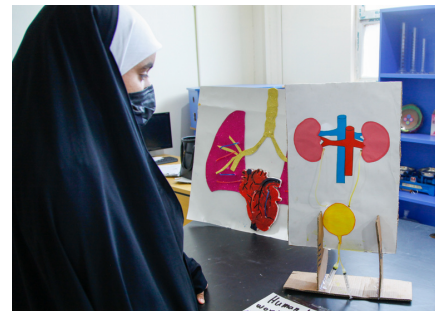

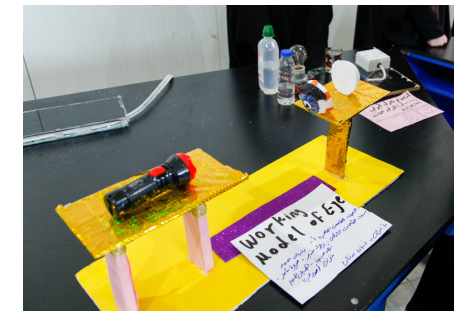

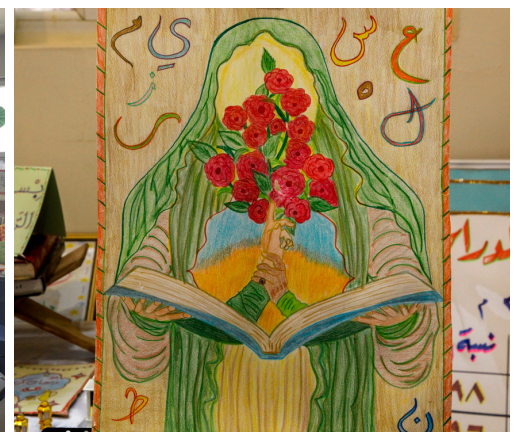
QURAN CITY
