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The new facility, the sensory room, provides students with a therapeutic space to help them calm and focus themselves so they can be better prepared for learning and interacting with others. As we continue to ensure academic proficiency in our students, we will be developing the following key skills in our students: effective communication in English and Arabic, both orally and in written form; being innovative and creative; the ability to critically-think; applying knowledge and skills to real-world settings; and, work collaboratively with others.

The intermediate and preparatory sections are provided with additional career counseling sessions to guide and give them a road map to their careers. 
FIELD TRIPS
