Dar Al-Zahra Charitable Schools shall continue supporting the students by providing a financial grant to graduates of Sixth Preparatory (Orphan Students) according to their percentage grade in the board exams (highest being IQD 10 million eqv USD\$ 8,333.33). The students shall receive the cash grant in quarterly installment that will assist students with living and housing expenses while they pursue their education at the university.
