

We are overjoyed to announce the successful graduation of our esteemed Grade 12 – Batch 7 students from Dar al Zahra. These young minds are not only university-ready but also equipped to become leaders of tomorrow. As they embark on their higher education journeys at various Iraqi universities, Dar al Zahra is supporting them with cash grants to assist with their academic pursuits and living expenses.

23 orphan students are eligible for a grant from the batch. 67 students appeared in the exam from the school, out of which 43 graduated, and 18 have secured admissions until now and are ready to start university.

GLOBAL KINDNESS FOUNDATION: 10 DAYS MEDICAL CAMP

In the month of October, our campus was transformed into a vibrant center of healing during the Global Kindness Foundation's (GKF) annual ten-day medical camp. Skilled dentists, physicians, audiologists, and opticians provided comprehensive screenings for our students, resulting in life-changing care.

This year, the dental team addressed complex, specialized cases, treating 141 sedation and 113 non-sedation students, 166 endo procedures, 330 extractions, 359 X-rays, and 38 hygiene scaling units. The optical team screened and provided glasses to 159 students, while our hearing health also received a significant boost as audiologists donated 17 pairs of hearing aids, five of which have already been adjusted and fitted for students and a staff member in need.

We extend our deepest gratitude to GKF for their generous commitment to the well-being of our students. This annual visit is a powerful testament to the transformative impact of collaboration and the profound power of kindness. By providing these vital resources—including the 17 pairs of hearing aids—the GKF ensures our students can see, hear, and smile more brightly as they pursue their education.
