### Smartboards installed in classrooms...

With the installation of smart boards in some of the classrooms (12 classrooms-primary section) and televisions in the halls, this has enriched the syllabus by taking a typical lesson and turning it into a fun and interactive learning experience.

Smart Boards have been an amazing tool to focus students' attention in the classroom, especially in primary section. Teachers report great success with having students come up and work out problems on the Smart Board in front of the classroom. Because the technology is interesting, children are eager to work with it, and teachers have taken advantage of this by having every student come up and work on the board.
