Our in-house school clinics play in the daily well-being of our orphan students. Located in both the girls' and boys' schools, our clinics are staffed and equipped to provide comprehensive healthcare services right on campus, ensuring a safe and healthy environment for every child.

Our goal is to manage a variety of medical needs and ensure students get the care they need promptly and professionally.

We are equipped to provide immediate first aid for minor injuries and illnesses, as well as in-patient care for more intensive needs, including administering essential medications like insulin and inhalers. We also assist selected students with nutritional support and conduct regular health screenings to identify issues early and ensure prompt specialist referrals when necessary.



PHARMACY

Our well-stocked pharmacy allows us to dispense medication as required, serving the essential health needs of our orphan students and their families. This crucial resource allows us to quickly and efficiently dispense necessary medications as required, ensuring that all our students receive prompt care and attention for their health concerns. We remain committed to maintaining a healthy and supportive environment for everyone!



SUPPORT SIRAJ WALID HIP REPLACEMENT SURGERY

Our Prep 6 student, Siraj Walid, is facing a serious health crisis requiring urgent support. Due to complications from a hip fracture, Siraj needs a total hip joint replacement. This chronic issue has caused a severe limp, led to scoliosis (spinal bending), and resulted in a significant mental toll, including clinical depression after losing two academic years.

We're appealing for funds to cover his surgery and post-operative care.
